Rules & Regulations for Electronics Guru '08

1. A team must consist of not more than two (2) members to participate in this competition.
2. The tools provided to you will be
 - i. PSpice
 - ii. Proteus
 - iii. OrCad
3. The competition will consist of task relating to Circuit Designing and Simulation. We will be testing your designing skills and how creative and handy you are with electrical equipments. Participants of all levels are encouraged to apply. The circuit details will be given out on the spot. In this the competitors will design and simulate a comparatively complex circuit.
4. The circuits will be judged on following criterion.
 - Logic and implementation.
 - Time consumed in making the circuit.
 - Size of circuit.
 - Number of components used in circuit.
 - Circuit Stability.
5. Registration Fee for Electronics Guru is Rs.100 per team for students of FT&IE and Rs. 150 per team for student of other departments.
6. The decision of the judges shall be final and unchallengeable.
7. In all matters concerning the competition, the decision of the **CEC committee** will be final and binding on all concerned.
8. Registration has to be submitted for each competition category, in case same applicant registers for different competitions.

Registration fees has to be submitted, to Mr Touseef VIP lab, in cash along with registration form. No registration form is acceptable without registration fee.
