Rules & Regulations for Project Guru '08

1. A team can consist of maximum four (4) members to participate in this competition.
2. Project must have an application and a proper documentation (poster, block diagrams etc).
3. A panel of judges will evaluate each project in the respective category during the one-day event. Participants are required to be present at the time of evaluation of their project by the panel of judges.
4. The Project will be evaluated on following criterion
 - Working Project
 - Novelty of design and Idea
 - Practical Aspects
 - Knowledge
 - Presentation
5. For computer interfacing projects, the only transferable mediums allowed for software are CD ROMs and USB device. Hard Disks are strictly prohibited.
6. If any project is found to be a replica of another project, the act shall be considered cheating and judges can disqualify participants and the entry fee shall be forfeited.
7. Only selected projects will be exhibited. Participants will not be allowed to display anything other than the selected projects.
8. Registration Fee for Project Guru is Rs.100 per person for students of FT&IE and Rs. 150 per person for student of other departments.
9. The decision of the judges shall be final and unchallengeable.
10. In all matters concerning the competition, the decision of the CEC committee will be final and binding on all concerned.
11. **CEC committee** reserves the right to disqualify any team without assigning any reason.
12. Registration has to be submitted for each competition category, in case same applicant registers for different competitions.

Registration fees has to be submitted, to Mr Touseef VIP lab, in cash along with registration form. No registration form is acceptable without registration fee.

CEC Committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.
