

CONVOCATION 2010

The University is holding its Eighth Convocation at 10.00 a.m. on Saturday the 13th March 2010 at **Jinnah Convention Center, Islamabad**. The following categories of graduates shall be eligible for receiving degrees/ medals:-

- a) The graduates of 2005-Entry who have completed their BSc Engineering Programme in **Civil, Computer, Electrical, Mechanical, Software, Electronics and Mechatronics Engineering** from the University up to **31st January, 2010**.
- b) The graduates of previous Entries who have completed their BSc Engineering Programme in **Civil, Computer, Electrical Mechanical and Software Engineering** from the University up to **31st January, 2010**, after the Seventh Convocation.
- c) The graduates who have completed **their MSc and PhD Programmes** from the University after the Seventh Convocation.

Note: The medals will be awarded to the graduates on the basis of overall best performance in the entire BSc Engineering Degree programme as well as best performance in Final Year Examination. Letters are being issued individually to such medalists.

Only those graduates will be allowed to attend the ceremony who attend **the rehearsal on Friday the 12th March, 2010 at 9.30 a.m.** and obtain the entry cards. Letters giving detailed instructions are also being sent to such graduates.

The convocation robes will be provided by the contractor on payment of Rs. 500/- as rent-cum-security on 12th March, 2010 at the time of rehearsal. The security will be refunded on return of the robes after deducting the rent on 13th March, 2010 after the convocation.

While attending the rehearsal, the graduates are required to bring with them the following documents:

1. Provisional Certificate (one attested photocopy)
2. National Identity Card (original with one attested photocopy)
3. Two recent photographs (bearing Regd. No. & Name on reverse)

The graduates may note that they will not be allowed to attend the convocation if:

1. they do not take part in the **rehearsal**,
2. They do not obtain the **entry card**,
3. They do not wear the **convocation robe**,
4. They do not have, with them, their **national identity card** and
5. They do not reach the **convocation place in time**.

Warning:

The graduates are directed to behave properly during the ceremony. In case of any behaviour not suitable for the grace of the ceremony, the degree is liable to be cancelled/ withheld.
